Gluten-Free Wafers

Non-alcoholic Communion wine is available at our 10.00am service for those who would value it. If you wish to receive it, having received the consecrated bread at the Altar rail, please place your hand across your body (right hand to left shoulder or the like) to clearly indicate that.
