Parents are welcome to stay with their children. There is a corner at the front of church for **pre-school age children** only. Strawberry Tea on **Sunday 19th August** at 3.00pm at the Vicarage. Please sign up on the list in Trinity room. Everybody welcome!

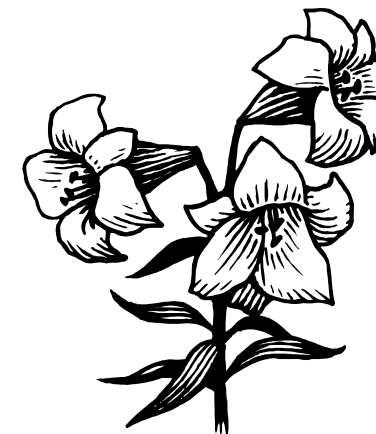
