# THE SECOND SUNDAY BEFORE ADVENT

## Welcome to Holy Trinity for our worship today.

If you are a visitor you are warmly welcome. If you normally receive Holy Communion in your own Church, then please do so here. If you prefer a blessing instead, bring your service booklet to the altar rail with you.

### Gluten-Free Wafers

Please let a church warden know before the start of the service if you need a gluten-free communion wafer.

**Non-alcoholic Communion wine** is available at our 10.00am Eucharist for those who would value it. Having received the consecrated bread at the altar rail, please place your hand across your body (e.g. right hand to left shoulder) to indicate that.

- **Children** from Nursery age upwards are encouraged to meet in the Trinity room at the beginning of the 10.00am service for **Junior Church** (except during school holidays). Parents are welcome to stay with their children. There is a corner at the front of church for **pre-school age children** only. Please feel free to supervise your child if they become restless in the pew, and tidy the corner before you leave.
