Gluten-Free Wafers

Please let a church warden know before the start of the service if you need a gluten-free communion wafer.

Non-alcoholic Communion wine is available at our 10.00am Eucharist for those who would value it. Having received the consecrated bread at the altar rail, please place your hand across your body (e.g. right hand to left shoulder) to indicate that.

Parents are welcome to stay with their children. There is a corner at the front of church for **pre-school age children** only.
