HOLY WEEK 2014

Holy Week begins today, **Palm Sunday**, with the procession to church from the Papermill pub at 9.40am. Palm crosses will be blessed there, and in church, during the service, there will be a reading of The Passion according to St Matthew.

Tomorrow evening, Monday, there will be a service of **Stations of The Cross at 8.00pm** using reproductions of Stations from Nairobi Cathedral.

On **Maundy Thursday**, the choir of All Saints and choir members of St Mary's, will lead the Sung Eucharist commemorating the Last Supper, with washing of feet, stripping of the altar and a vigil of prayer until 10.00pm.

On **Good Friday** there is a children's workshop at 11.30am and a traditional Stations of the Cross with hymns at 2.00pm.

Easter Eve on Saturday is marked with the Easter Vigil at 9.00pm - lighting of the Easter Fire, blessing of the Paschal Candle, renewal of baptismal vows and the first eucharist of Easter. There are refreshments in the Refectory afterwards.

On **Easter Day** we celebrate Jesus' resurrection with a said eucharist at 9.00am and a sung eucharist at 10.00am
