Please note that the PILGRIM meeting scheduled for this Tuesday has been postponed until after Lent as the Churches Together Lent meetings will be taking place each week in Lent.

The Churches Together Lent course is one of the sessions in the PILGRIM course – The Lord's Prayer. Monday morning sessions begin on Monday 23rd February at 10.30am at Christ Church. Tuesday evening sessions will be hosted by the Methodists – the venue/time to be confirmed. **St Mary's, Apsley** is following a course based on the film 'The Way'. It tells the story of a bereaved father setting out to walk the famous pilgrim's Way of Santiago de Compostela, and in the course of his pilgrimage encounters a number of other pilgrims. The film will be screened on Tuesday 24th February at 7.30pm and then subsequent meetings are on 4th/ 9th/17th/24th March each evening at 7.45pm.

Lent Smarties Tube Challenge Once again the congregation is being asked to give up using 20p pieces during Lent and instead store them in a Smarties tube and return them to church to support fundraising in 2015. For the next few Sundays there will be tubes (full of Smarties!) available for you. Eat the Smarties, fill the tube with 20p pieces (or even £1 coins!) and bring them back on Easter Day 5th April. If you fill the tube earlier, then please return it early – you can even exchange it for another Smarties-filled tube for an extra challenge! On return, please ensure your name is written on the tube, and hand it in during the offertory hymn. This ensures we are able to claim back Gift Aid for those registered as Gift Aid givers. On Easter Day there will be an extra large offertory receptacle!
