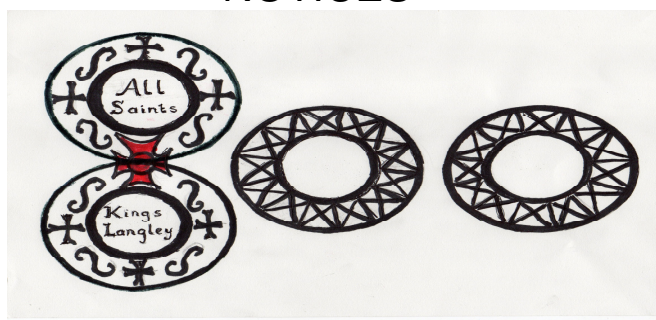
## PRAYERS
