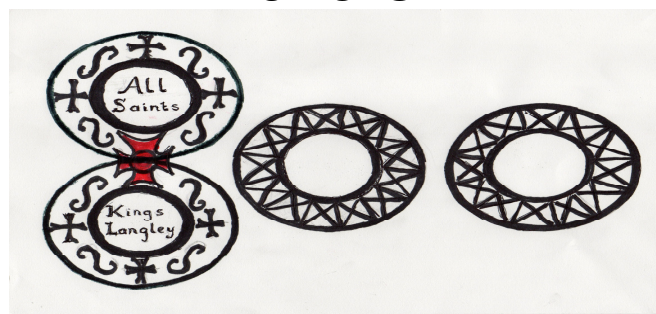
PRAYERS
