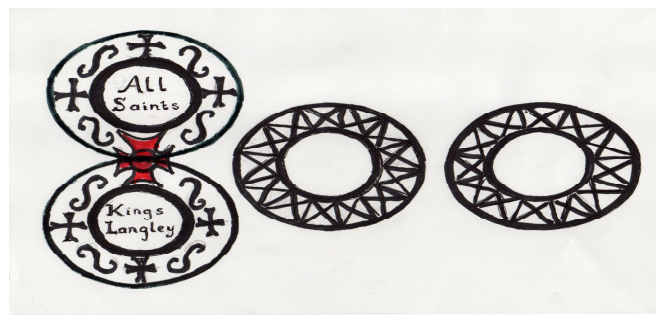
## PRAYERS
