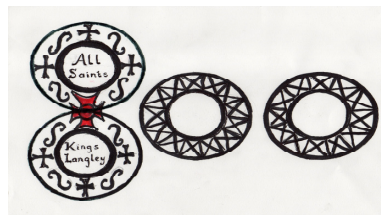
PRAYERS
