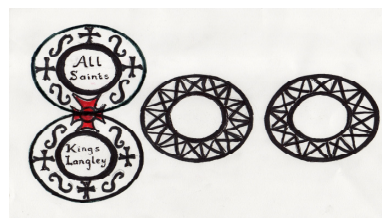
## PRAYERS
