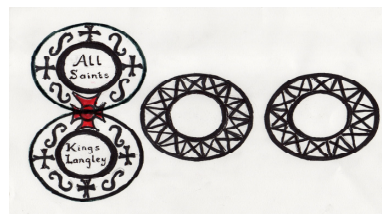
PRAYERS
