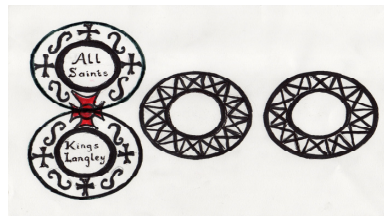
PRAYERS
