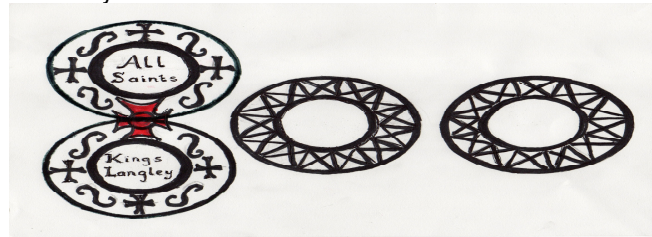
PRAYERS
