A word of explanation! David has not yet retired but hopefully soon. Under the new arrangements in the team, Richard is the Team Vicar of St Mary's and St Benedict's, Lizzie is Team Vicar of Holy Trinity and David, as Team Rector, is priest-in-charge of All Saints. David will continue to offer Richard 25% support at St Mary's and Lizzie will offer him 25% support at St Benedict's. This means that each church has 75% of ordained ministry. The reason for this arrangement is because at present our team is only entitled to 3 stipendiary clergy. It is felt that the current arrangement is the best way to share 3 full time clergy among 4 churches.
