Our 10am service **TODAY** is a non-Eucharistic family service, celebrating grandparents, and relationships across generations.

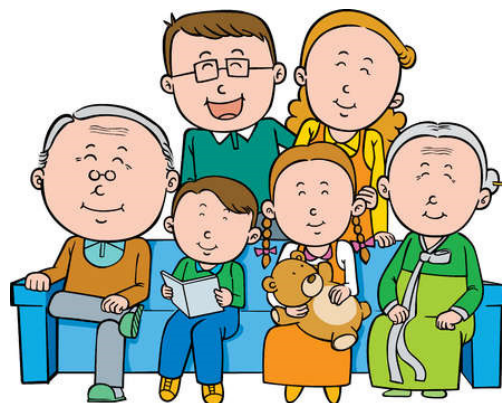
The office will close at 2.30pm on Friday for one week, re-opening at 8am on Monday 4th September.
