Fridah and family live in a rented corrugated metal shelter in Nairobi. There is no running water, space is extremely limited. Rent, school fees, water and food all depend on what she can earn. Things changed when she joined an urban farming project run by CA's partner, Beacon of Hope, through training, tools and seeds. Hidden at the end of a narrow alley, Fridah has created something remarkable. Vegetables grow in repurposed containers, leafy greens climb every available space. As she puts it, 'Now I can plan. I can help my family.'
